

Jonah and the Big Fish  
Jonah 1:1-3:10

Jonah was a prophet of God. One day, God told Jonah, "Go to the big city of Nineveh. Tell them to stop doing bad things."

But Jonah ran away. He did not want to go to Nineveh. Instead he got on a boat to sail across the sea. God sent a big storm to stop Jonah. The sailors on the boat were afraid. They thought the boat was going to sink!

Jonah told the sailors, "My God has sent this storm. If you throw me into the water, the sea will become calm again."

So the sailors threw Jonah into the raging sea. Instantly, the sea became calm.

5. Do you think Jonah listened to God the next time God told him to do something?

## Craft ideas:

### JONAH and the GREAT FISH

#### Supplies Needed:

- Spring type clothes pin that opens and closes
- Crayons, markers or colored pencils
- Colored Paper or Foam Board
- Glue or hot glue gun and glue stick
- scissors

#### Instructions:

1. Color pattern of fish and Jonah
2. Cut out the fish and Jonah
3. Cut fish in half following line
4. Line fish halves on clothes pin with tail just covering the metal part of the pin (**1 ½" of the pin will be visible**)
5. Glue top half of fish on upper part of clothes pin
6. Glue bottom half of fish on lower part of clothes pin
7. Glue Jonah on the lower half of clothes pin behind the lower half of the fish

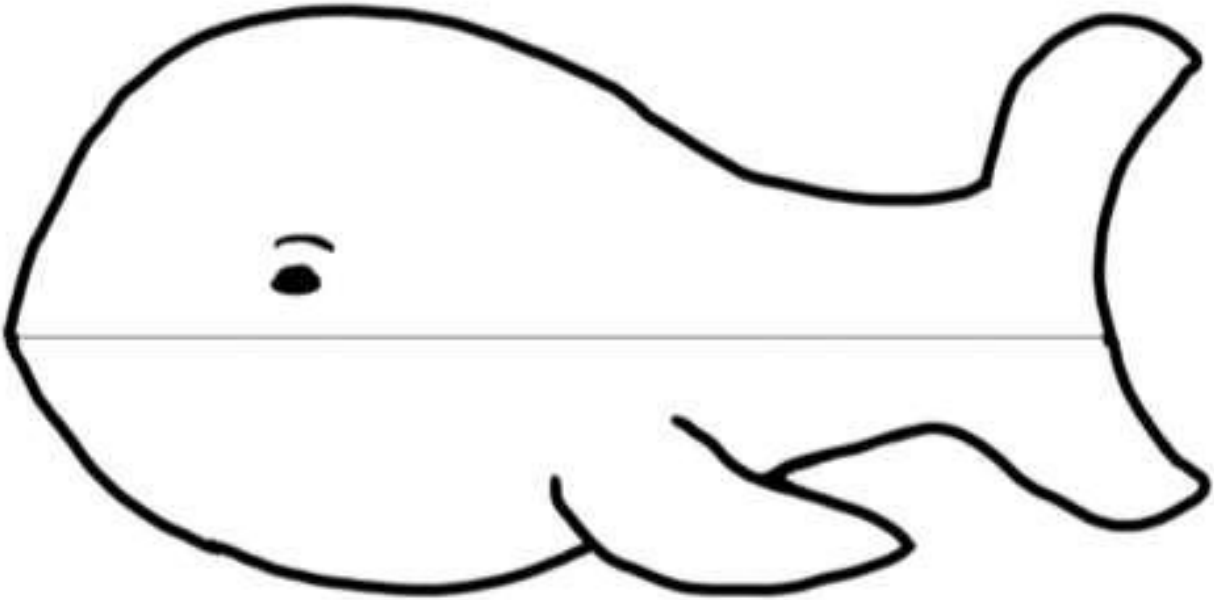
#### *Other options:*

*Use colored paper or foam board for the fish cutout*

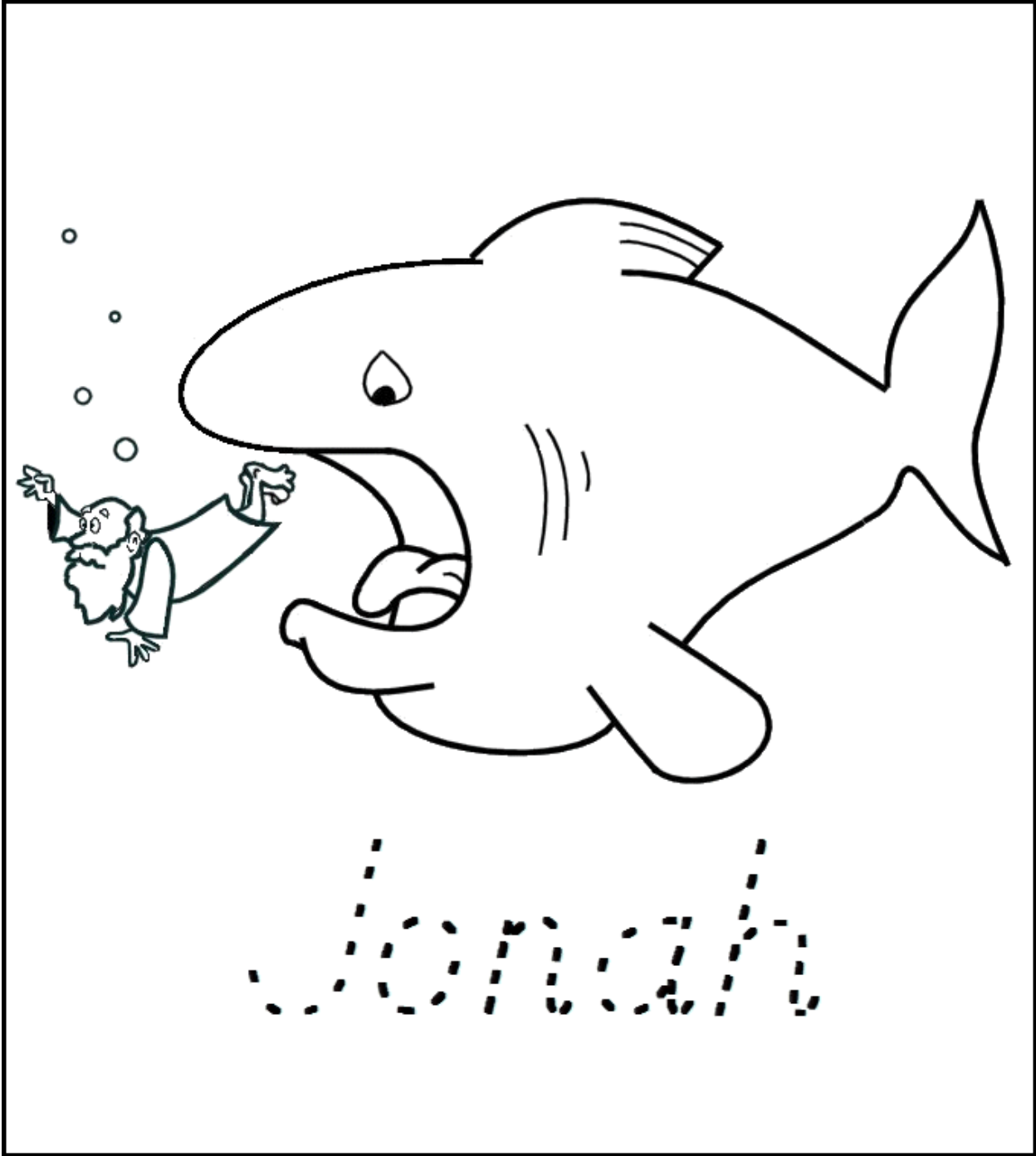
Jonah Cut-Out
