Monday night (on September 19), the Presbytery’s Commission on Ministry approved the Interim Pastor Search Committee’s candidate. Session had voted its approval the Thursday before, so the “way was clear” and all the i’s have been dotted and the t’s crossed. We welcome The Reverend Dr. Kimberly (Kim) L. Clayton as our Interim Senior Pastor. She is a graduate of Columbia Theological Seminary-top of her class, and more recently received her D Min from Columbia Seminary. Kim was ordained as a minister of Word and Sacrament in 1984. She has a wide variety of experiences, pastoring churches for over 20 years, then some administrative and teaching work on the seminary level. About 6 years ago, she attended the Interim Ministry Training Workshop and has been in 3 churches for 2 years each since then. They include Brick Presbyterian Church in NYC, Trinity Presbyterian in Atlanta and most recently, The Presbyterian Church in Fredericksburg, VA. Both Trinity and Brick are larger than Second.

The Committee’s long list of criteria included good preaching and teaching skills, as well as several successful interim pastorates at one or more large churches. Finding someone that met the standards and experience was a daunting task, but Kim exceeded our expectations. We are very excited that she has chosen to serve her next interim pastorate with us! Kim will be in the office on Monday, September 9 and will preach at both services on September 15th. Following the 11 o’clock service, there will be a lunch for Kim, organized by the Fellowship Committee. We hope to see lots of you there!

Supplies needed include: tupperware, pot holders, shower curtain, bath rug, coffee maker/tea kettle, blender, wall clock, plunger, bucket/mop and laundry baskets. We will continue to keep the congregation updated on the arrival of our new family. In the meantime, we continue to pray for strength and safe travels for all refugees making their way to the Bluegrass state.

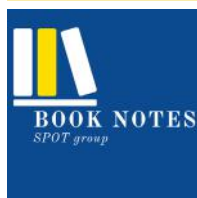
